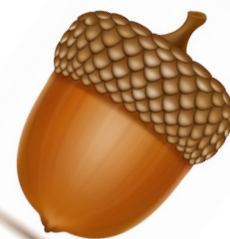


ACORN'S TERM 1



Over this week we will be setting up Tapestry, ready to be used by ourselves and for you to use as parents.

Tapestry allows you to login with a secure username and password so you can view all your children's observations, photographs and videos. You can like and comment on observations that we add for your child and it's also possible for you to add your own observations, you may wish to add homework on here too! Your comments and own observations will allow us to find out about which activities your child really enjoyed and the learning they get up to at home.

Miss Bingham and Mrs Jones will link observations to the EYFS framework so you will know which area of learning your child is achieving in and the age-band they were working in for that activity.

We will set you up using your email address and once this has been done, you will receive an activation email from which you can set up your own password to login with. You will also be asked to set up a 4-digit PIN which you can use on the Tapestry app to quickly log back in once you've initially logged in. Do remember to keep an eye out on your spam/junk folders for this email. Once your account is up and running you will be able to login using any web browser from tapestryjournal.com or by downloading the Tapestry app from the Play or App store, depending on what type of device you are using.

All About Me Term 1 Curriculum

Maths: We will be learning matching and sorting, comparing amounts and creating simple patterns.

RE: Our topic for this term is about God and creation, why is the word 'God' so important to Christians?

PE: We will be doing games centered around walking and the different ways and directions that we can walk.

Reading: We will be starting to learn initial phonetic sounds and tricky words. Our sounds for this term are s, a, t, p, i, n.

Writing: We will be practising writing and recognising our names whilst improving our grasps with pencils.

We have a key text that we will be focusing on which is 'The Colour Monster' and 'The Colour Monster goes to school', other texts that will be explored will be centred around our topic and self-care.

Reading Books

This term the children will be issued with a picture book that they have chosen from our library. These will be issued every Monday and Thursday. Please encourage your child to read and write it in their reading record book.

Home learning

Home learning will be set with six tasks; these do not have to be completed in order and can be done at any time during Term 1. These can be completed and brought into school for their homework books, or via tapestry.

PE

Our PE days for Term 1 will be Wednesday for dance and Friday. It has been noted that there is a delay with PE kits arriving so if your child has not received their kits then they can come into school wearing trainers.

Wellie Boots

Please could your child bring wellie boots into school for them to use the mud kitchen. If you do not wish the wellie boots to stay in school these can be sent home daily.
