History and Geography: Explorers

Linked to our English we will be learning about significant explorers, going to the moon! We will be thinking about what it is to be an explorer, where they go and what do explorers need and why.







Religious Education: We will be learning the Nativity Story and thinking about the meaning of Christmas and why Christmas is important to Christians. We will be performing our Nativity play.



Maths: We will be learning number bonds, times tables, place value, shape and more! Our maths learning is linked to our topic.
