Use your favourite story to create your own version. Use short sentences and sequencing terms 'Then, Next, finally'. Use your imagination!



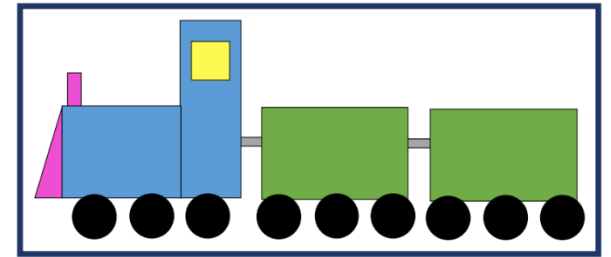
Phonics

Then have a go at drawing another picture, exploring the different ways you can show 10.



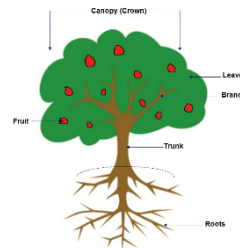
Physical Development
