## Complete one homework task each week (there are more here than you need).

Music Choose a song by the Beatles and then choose one of your favourite songs. Try and pick a song that was written recently or is played a lot on the radio now. What is the name of the song? Who is singing the song? Is it a band or a soloist?* What is the song about? What is the tempo?* What is your favourite lyric?*	Science How can you make the sound of a drum louder? How could a ruler on a table be 'twanged' to make (a) a higher note? (b) a louder note? What do you notice as you are testing these things out?	History Interview a family member or friend and find out what they remember about the 1950's, 1960's or 1970's.  Can they tell you about more than one decade?	Art one of the Beatles' most famous songs is 'Yellow Submarine.' Here is an animated version of the song: Imagine you are going on a journey in the yellow submarine. What would you see? Who would you meet? Could it be the Beatles themselves? Draw a picture of your adventure. Don't forget to include a yellow submarine in the picture!
Sport What were the most popular sports after WWII? What famous sporting events have taken place since then? Choose a big event and tell us about the highlights. Can you present as if you were a reporter at the time?	Pance Find out about the different types of dance moves from one of the decades since WWII.  Can you make up your own dance to some of the music from that decade?  Can you find out some of the famous moves?  Practice them so that you could teach them to someone else.	DT Ask an adult if you can make a 1960s- themed meal or cake. There are some ideas here:	TV You can watch an episode of 'Watch with Mother' here:   ('Watch with Mother Paper Lantems'). • Why do you think the episode is in black and white? • Do you think children enjoyed watching these programmes? Why? • Do you think the sausage dog is helpful or silly? Why? • Do you think Bizzy Lizzy wished for sensible things? Why? Try and follow the lady's instructions to make a paper lantem. You don't need to use wallpaper – a normal piece of paper will work just as well. Don't forget to take a photo and send it to school if you make one.
