<p>English Write a diary extract from the viewpoint of a family member in Sparta or in Ancient Greece. Try to write about your feelings about daily life.</p>	<p>Science What is your favourite animal? Where is its habitat? How does it fit into a food chain? Think about how you will present your knowledge and research.</p>	<p>History Create a fact file or poster about a Greek God. Make sure your poster is eye-catching and full of facts and information.</p>	<p>Art Turn a myth into a cartoon, for example, Theseus and the Minotaur. Use lots of speech bubbles.</p>
<p>Sport Write an advert persuading people to visit the ancient Olympic Games. Which events would they see? What else might they witness?</p>	<p>RESEARCH Research ancient Greek art. Create your top 10 facts about artists or famous pieces.</p>	<p>DT Find out about the clothes Ancient Greeks wore. You could draw and label a picture showing a typical Ancient Greek outfit, or create one which you could wear!</p>	<p>Geography Can you plot the journey of Daedalus and Icarus – how far did they travel? Where did they start out? Where did they finish up?</p>
<p>History/Geography Make a collage using pictures from holiday brochures or the internet showing ancient buildings and interesting place to visit in Greece.</p>	<p>Maths Who was Pythagoras? How is he linked to maths? What is Pythagoras' theory? Present your findings – use diagrams to explain what you have learnt.</p>	<p>Languages Find out some simple Greek phrases. E.g Hello, How are you? What's your name? etc. Can you make a poster to display them in Greek and English? If you can learn the pronunciation, can you try and teach us at school?</p>	<p>History/DT Make a Spartan helmet or design a shield.</p>
<p>DT Plan, design and make your own labyrinth for King Minos to trap the minotaur.</p>	<p>DT Research Greek food. How is it different to traditional English food? You could recreate your own Greek dish, and write a recipe for others to follow.</p>	<p>English Make a travel brochure about Ancient Greece. Where would you travel to? Where would you stay? What could you do while you were there? Who would you recommend to visit? Use pictures with lots of facts and information.</p>	<p>Thinking skills Make an A-Z of Greece. Think about presenting your work in the best way possible. What could you do on the border? You could add an illustration to each or some of the letters along with small pictures linked to your sentences.</p>
