### Topic: What is a Pirate?

You can choose and complete any of these tasks in any order. You can bring your home learning into school for sharing or send via email.

#### English Focus

Create a Pirate! – Draw a picture of a pirate.  
Label or write sentences to describe your pirate.  
What is their name? What clothes do they wear?  
What objects to they have a why?



#### Maths Focus

Create a pirate treasure map. Decide where to hide the pirate's treasure. Write a secret letter to another pirate, giving directions of how to find the treasure. Maybe buried by the palm tree or edge of a cliff!



#### Science Focus

Create a food diary, drawing and writing the food you have for breakfast, lunch and dinner. What food helps your body to grow? Create a poster of healthy and not so healthy food.



#### Creative Focus

Create a pirate ship – you can draw this or creative modelling. Name your ship, create a flag showing the name of your ship.



#### Topic – History & Geography Pirates

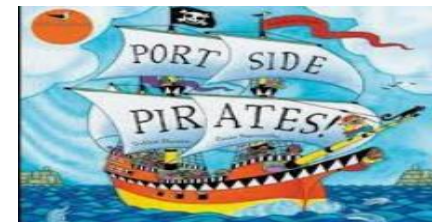
