Can you use paper circles and organise toys or house items into groups more than 10? Example: Group of 13 spoons, group of 15 Lego pieces.



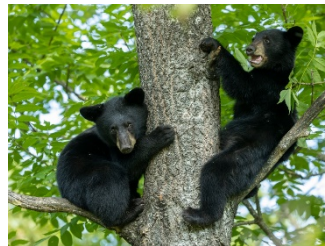
Physical Development
