Design and annotate an outfit for both a rich and a poor Tudor. What materials would they be made from? What colours were popular?



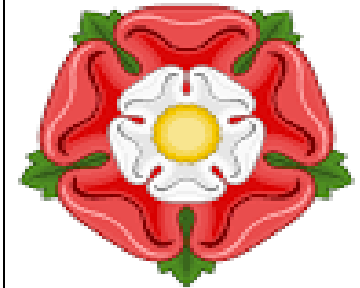
Computing – Scratch

English

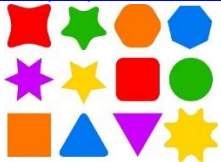
Write a short story set in Tudor times.

Music

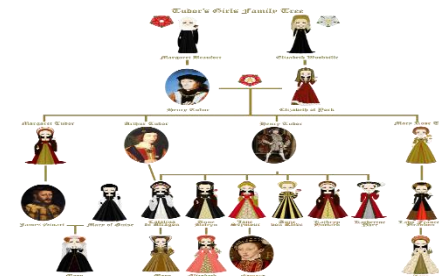
Learn, practise (and eventually perform) a Tudor dance or song. The website below might give you some ideas:
