Term 6 – Around the World

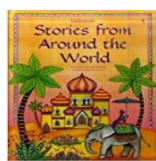
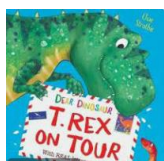
This term we will continue to build on our knowledge and understanding from exploring the oceans and will learn more about the continents and different animals and their habitats. We will continue to explore globe, finding countries, learning about the equator, linking weather to habitats.

We are pleased with the progress in reading so please continue to ensure reading books and contact books are in school every day. Logins for Spelling Shed and TTRS are in their books for the children to log in, learn, and have fun.

The phonics screening test for Year 1 will be this term so please use the phonic websites on the school's web page to help your child with their confidence for this.

PE is still on Monday and Wednesday – come to school in PE clothes, sports shoes and have a named water bottle. We will be learning dance on Wednesdays.

English – Our stories are linked to Geography, animal stories from different continents. The stories chosen also help to link previous learning. 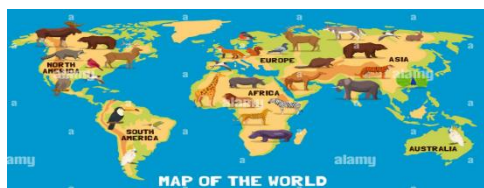
Maths
