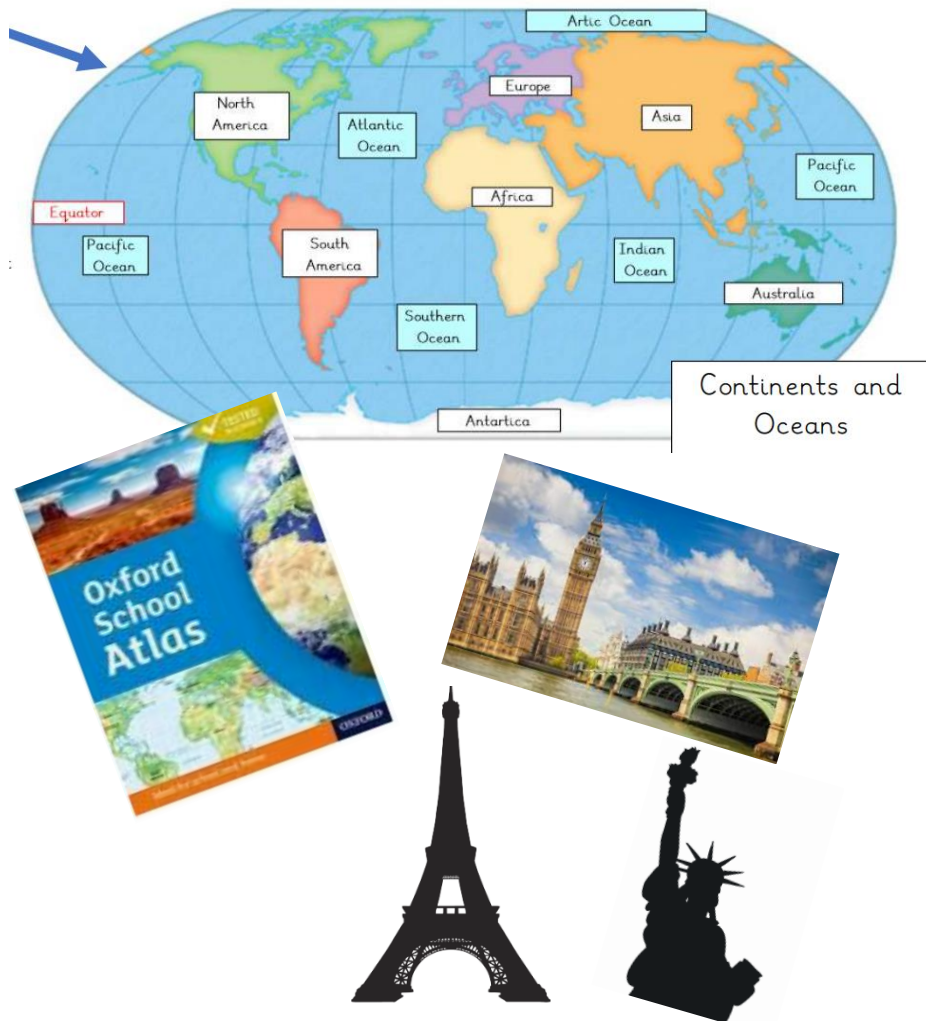

| Oceans | An ocean is a huge body of salt water. |
| Sea | Sea is a large body of salty water, part of the ocean. |
| Continents | A continent is a massive area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features. |
| River | A moving body of water that flows from its source into another body of water. |
| Habitats | A habitat is a place that an animal lives. It provides the animal with food, water and shelter. There are many different sorts of habitats around the world from forests to grasslands and from mountain slopes to deserts. Different habitats are home to different animals. |
| Island | A piece of land surrounded by water. |
| City | A large town. London and Manchester are cities. |
| Landmark | A large object on land that is easy to see and can help people find their way. An important building or monument. |
| Atlas | A book of maps and charts. |
| Globe | A globe is a spherical model of Earth. |
| Equator | An equator is an imaginary line around the middle of the earth. It is halfway between the north pole and the south pole. Earth is widest at its Equator. |
