Reading

We have noticed a decrease in children's reading at home. It is very important children read at home as it will help them in school as well as at home to confidently read and write. We check reading records every Monday and Thursday.

Homework

Homework will be set with six tasks; these do not have to be completed in order and can be done at any time during Term 6. These can be completed and brought into school for their homework books, or via tapestry so that we can celebrate the learning that is being done at home.

Our Wonderful World Term 6 Curriculum

Maths: Our focus for this term is subtraction. We will be looking at how to take away numbers from another number within a number sentence. There will be opportunities during own learning and home learning to practise their maths.

RE: Our topic for this term is 'Faiths around the world'. We will be learning about all the faiths that are around the world and looking at artifacts from those faiths.

Reading: We will continue to change books weekly. It is important that the children are reading each week at home, and it is being recorded in their reading record books. Reading is important for developing children's phonics and helps them to build important language skills.

Writing: Each child's handwriting has come on amazingly! We will continue to practise our letter formation and we are beginning to write short descriptive sentences in Literacy.

This term we are exploring all of our values and about Pentecost.
