You can choose and complete any of these tasks in any order or think of some of your own. You can bring your home learning into school for sharing or send via email.

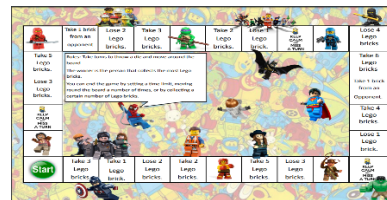
English
