### Term 1 – Great Fire of London

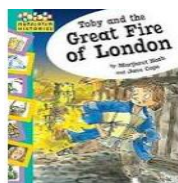
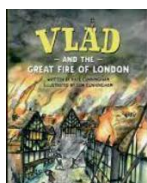
Term 1 begins our learning journey, learning where and how The Great Fire of London started, what happened during the fire and how it changed the landscape of London.

Link maths to your everyday and practise writing numbers. Play board games like snakes and ladders to support knowledge and understanding.

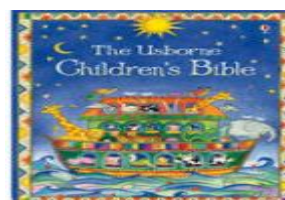
#### Science – Everyday Materials.
