How long have toys existed?

How are modern toys different? Many modern toys use electricity and computers and invented in the 20th Century.

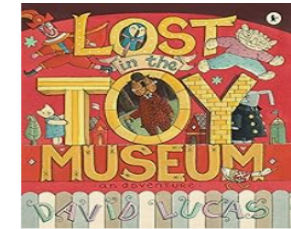
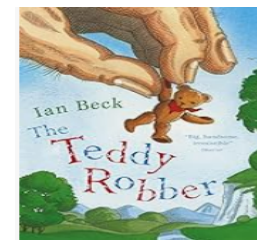
Exploring London
