You can complete these tasks in any order, and they can be completed in your homework book or you can send them via email to Mrs Grimwood. Be as creative as you like.

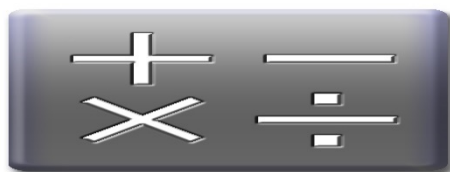
History/Art

Maths

Use a dice to create 5 multiplication questions either 4 digit by 1 digit or 3 digit by 2 e.g. 3456×3 or 234×24 .
Then do the same to create 5 division questions e.g. $375 \div 5 =$ or $545 \div 15 =$



English/History

Write a poem for Remembrance Day. Think about the poems that we have read – 'In Flanders Fields' and 'We Remember' and use this to help inspire you to write your own poem.



History

Create your own trench.

- Research the layout of trenches.
- What different sections are there within a trench?
