We have looked at cost and quality of items and should be able to have this in place later in term 3.

Attendance

Once again, thank you for your ongoing support and efforts to ensure children are in school each day. Thank you to parents who call in and speak with the office to report absence, rather than leaving a message or sending an email. Mrs Huynh will call to follow up on any absence, so thank you in advance for your cooperation with this. At the end of term we celebrated children who had achieved 100% attendance and children who had managed to improve their attendance, with there being a prize awarded in each category.

A few attendance points of information:

- If your child has medication but is feeling better and can return to school we are able to administer this. Speak to the office in order to complete the necessary paperwork so that your child can get back to school as soon as possible.
- Absence is authorised if the reason is deemed viable. Please do not be offended if you are asked to provide







additional information regarding an absence. The burden of proof is on parents to provide the information. We, of course, understand there are times when we are unwell but there may be occasions when further conversations around absence are needed.

- Attendance is monitored and tracked, and we shall be writing to some families this term as part of this process regarding absence and punctuality.
- Holidays in term time can not be authorised and may lead to a penalty notice being issued per child for each parent. There is new government legislation around this which I sent out last term.
